Community begins here

We are thrilled to announce our **BUILDING TO SERVE: Community Begins Here**, \$5 million capital campaign. Since 1985 Face to Face has worked to restore dignity and hope to those suffering in the Germantown and surrounding communities. Beginning with a hot, delicious meal we holistically address our guests' needs through our Health, Legal and Social Services centers. We also work to give the children of our community the educational and social support they need to escape the poverty that engulfs them.

Our wonderful building allows us to offer all of our programs under one roof. Rather than send a client across town to see a lawyer or a nurse, we simply direct them across the hallway to receive the assistance they need. The building however, is 132 years old and in serious need of renovation. The goal of our campaign is to increase our capacity to serve. In order to accomplish that we will modernize and expand the kitchen and dining room, improve the common areas and renovate 7,000 square feet of space on the lower level, which will be designated exclusively for our children's programs.

We are delighted to share that to date we have raised \$3.6 million toward our \$5 million goal. We are asking you, and all of our supporters, to
